

REOPENING RULES & GUIDELINES (PUBLIC)

MONDAY, MAY 18, 2020 at 8:00 am

- 6' Social Distancing AT ALL TIMES.
- All people coming to campus are **strongly encouraged** to wear masks covering the mouth and nose areas. All persons coming to any ANC campus are encouraged to bring your own mask.
- DO NOT ENTER if:
 - You have had a fever of 100.4°F or higher in the past 2 days
 - You have a cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms typical of Covid-19
 - You have had known exposure to someone with Covid-19 in the past 14 days
 - You have traveled outside a 100 mile radius, especially to “hot spots” for COVID-19 cases (examples include New York, Louisiana, New Jersey, and Connecticut)
- You may wish to refrain from entering if you are 65 or more years old or have underlying health conditions including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, severe obesity, asthma or immunocompromising conditions, because such individuals are at higher risk for severe illness if infected by Covid-19.
- Hand sanitizing stations are placed throughout the College.
- Lines are marked in high traffic areas for maintaining a distance of 6 feet between people. Please adhere to these distances.
- Refrain from any physical contact with others—no hand shaking, touching, or embracing,
- Seating must follow strict physical distancing protocols with 6 feet between individuals.
- Sanitization of all high-touch surfaces and common areas will take place throughout the day.
- Campus entrances will be limited to help maintain social distancing. All exterior doors will remain locked except for the following (a map is attached).

ENTRANCES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

John P. Sullins Admin. Bldg. – 1) The main entry by the bell monument and the reception desk 2) West door at the end of B - Wing. 3) North / Side door

Statehouse Hall - The front door that enters thru the H. Claude Bush Honor Plaza (Clock Tower).

Center for Allied Technologies – 1) The east door under the tower 2) The west door under the bus shed.

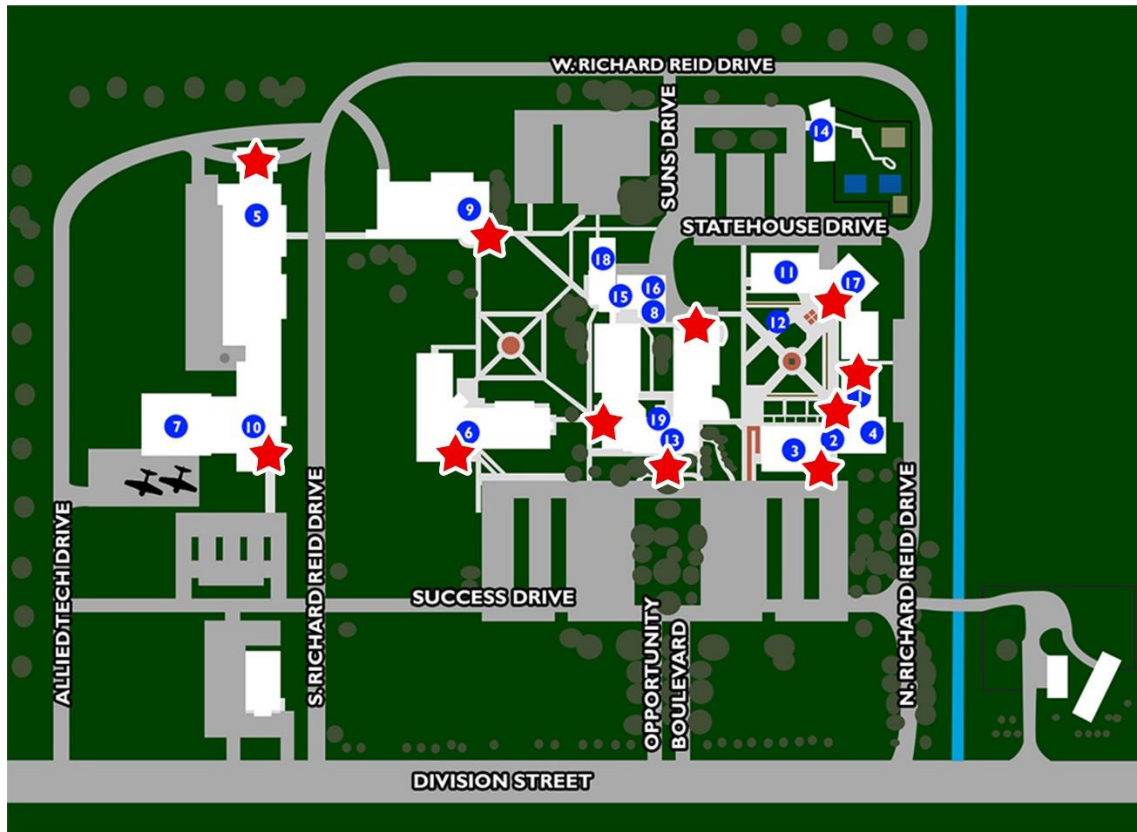
