## What is an INET class?

INET classes are online classes that do not have a prescribed meeting time listed in the class schedule. Course content and assignments are loaded into the myANC course, often in one-week increments. Students can watch videos lectures, read uploaded content and submit assignments during the week at the times that work best for them, keeping in mind that there are usually weekly due dates.

All INET courses will have at least one proctored assignment, often the final. Most students come to campus for their proctored assignment but there are alternate locations and online proctoring solutions available. There is no cost associated with proctoring on our campus but any costs associated with alternate proctoring is the responsibility of the student.

Students taking INET classes will need internet access and although students can access their courses on mobile devices, a computer is often needed to perform some assignments.
